CLEAR SNOW AND ICE FROM METERS

Snow and ice buildup can damage gas meters and pipes and make them difficult to reach in an emergency. Blocked vents for dryers and other gas appliances can lead to a dangerous buildup of carbon monoxide.

- Use a broom or brush to safely remove snow and ice from meters, pipes, and vents. Do not use ice-melting chemicals, salt, shovels or sharp-edged tools.
- Make sure the meter is visible to snowplow drivers if it is near a street or sidewalk.
- Repair leaks on eaves where water can drip onto your meter and freeze.
- Don't bury the meter when removing snow from your roof.
